

The first school was built of stone and was on the north side of the road. The pupils had only the road for playground. The new site was purchased in 1875, and the brick school house built. The new playgrounds were found to be too small to accommodate the number of pupils, and were enlarged in 1925. A wire fence was put around it, using iron posts. Blasting was done in order to get the posts into the ground.

Total value of school is \$2449.40 (1950's)
