He was well known throughout the district. His wife, the former Frances Weese, predeceased him several years ago. He leaves one son, Dr. Richard Street, with whom he resided, and three daughters. One sister, Mrs. J. T. Pelton, of Toronto, also survives along with one brother, Alfred Street, of Kingston.
The remains are resting at the Reid funeral parlors, Kingston, where the funeral service will be held Tuesday at 2 p.m. Interment will be made in Kingston cemetery.

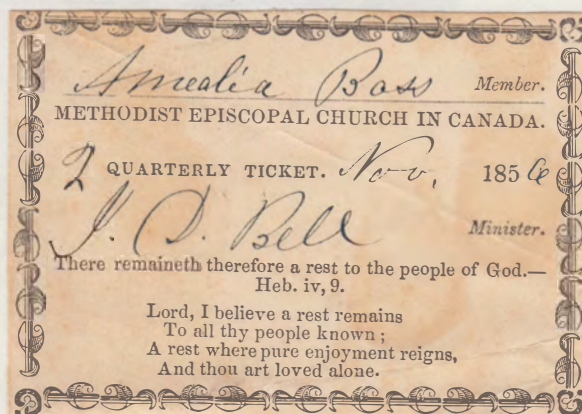
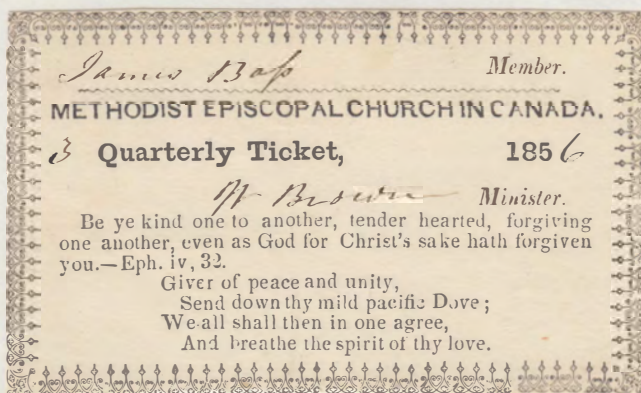
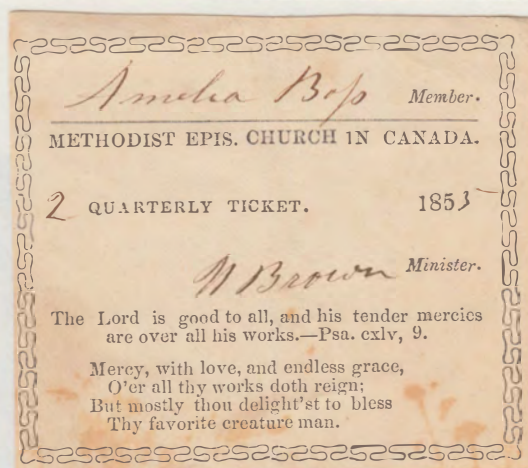
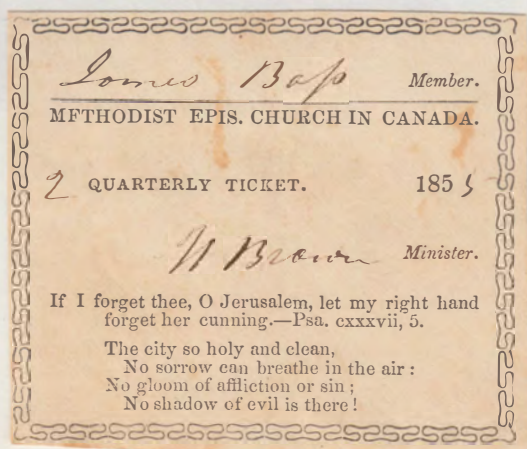
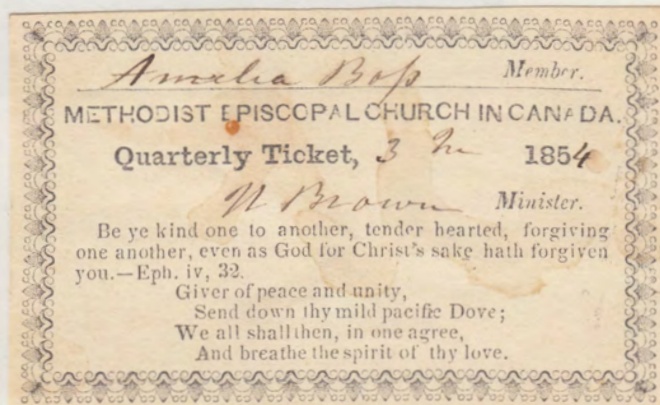
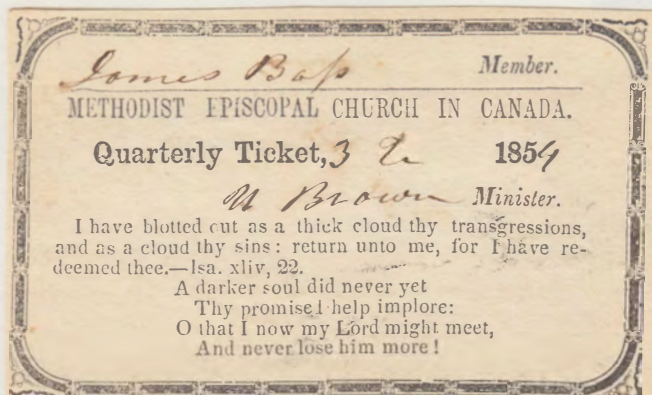

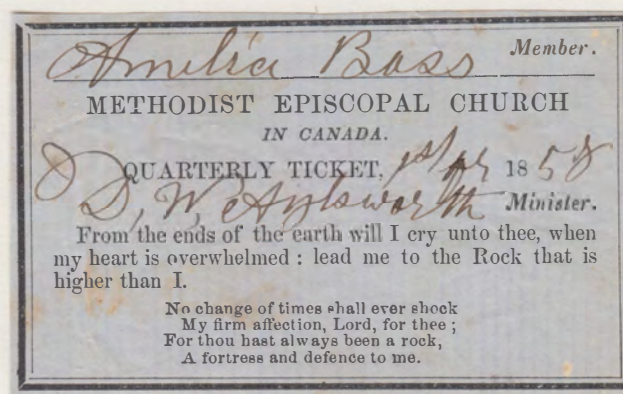
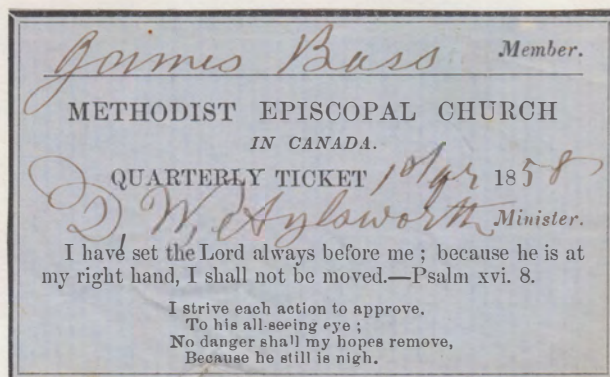
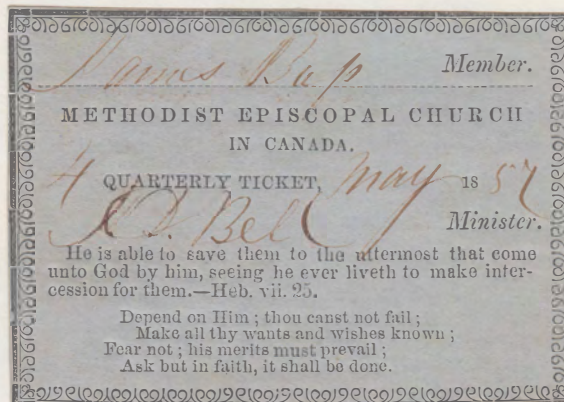
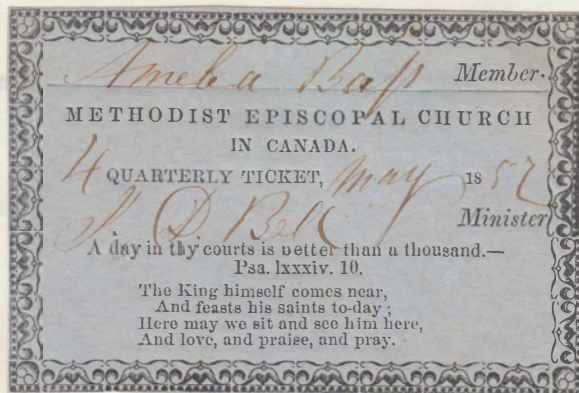
Signed by the resident minister, these tickets showed that the person named was in good standing in the local church.
