PASSES

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who can borrow items from this collection? Augusta Township residents or non-residents (cardholder in good standing for 6+ months)

Do I need identification to borrow things? You must show your library card when borrowing or renewing materials. An adult (18+) must sign a liability waiver.

How long can I keep something I've borrowed? Up to one (1) week.

Are there fees? We charge replacement fees for lost or damaged items. Deposits on borrowed passes and recreation equipment may be forfeited if items are not returned on time.

Do I have to come in to the library to return or renew things? YES. Items must be returned to our circulation desk during open hours.
